Coach Brown:

- Thank you to all the parents for the fun ride to state champions!
- Jersey's are ordered and Coach Wiske will have them ready in March
- Next year is the year to order new jerseys. 50% discount on 2 sets of jerseys and full price for the Jordan jersey. Only 2 other teams in Wisconsin have the Jordan Jersey for home games. We were chosen to do this. Home-Jordan; Away-Nike; 3rd set for Freshman for away games (\$7000 which is 50% off for 60 jerseys) Total \$38,000. School will pay \$4500 for the uniforms. Gridiron will pay around \$33,500 paid in September. Last time we bought uniforms was 4 years ago and the cost was \$42000. All
- 7 v7 tournament on Sundays \$80 per player at the ROCK. For Juniors and Seniors. \$1500 per team and the families pay per player. Non contact from the coaches.
- Coach just returned from a FB clinic.
